Special Highlight: Poster Presentations

特別なハイライト：ポスター発表

The capstone project in IES class is the Research Project and Poster Presentation. Students choose a topic at the beginning of AUAP and work on writing an interview-based research paper throughout the cycle. In addition, students learn computer skills in Word, Excel, and PowerPoint to create a full-size digital poster. They also work on presentation skills. At the end of AUAP, students present their research and results to other AUAP students, WWU students, and WWU faculty and staff. It is a great experience to add to their resume!
